

# EAL Level 2 First Diploma in Engineering Technology

## Information Sheet

### Background

The EAL Level 2 First Diploma in Engineering Technology (QAN 600/6868/1) requires the learner to complete **one** or **two** synoptic assessments, in which the mark, or marks, contributes towards the learner's grade. This document intends to demonstrate how a Centre can fully certificate with one synoptic assessment or two synoptic assessments and still ensure that the claim remains compliant with EAL guidelines.

### The Process

Below is a screenshot of the claim screen (see 'Certification Guidance' under Guidance Documents for further information on reaching this point). The two synoptic assessments indicated are both mandatorily required to be filled in when making a claim:

You may then proceed to select any remaining units that the learner has achieved as normal, and proceed to save the claim in the usual fashion.
