<p>Qualification Overview:</p>	<p>This qualification is a Vocationally Related Qualification (VRQ) which focuses on the knowledge and, where appropriate, the practical skills associated with lean business improvement. This arrangement ensures that when the learner completes the qualification they will have gained some practical experience and expectation of some of the situations that they could face within the occupational sector in which it is being delivered.</p> <p>It covers the intermediate level knowledge and understanding of lean business improvement and has been developed in consultation with colleges, training associations and industry to ensure that it meets the needs of employers and learners.
