The Level 3 QCF is designed to have a ‘hands on’ practical approach to manage a transport fleet in a safe, environmental and efficient way.</p> <p>The content and structure of the qualification has been developed to provide a broad based introduction to the practices and processes detailing effects of the transport industry relating to climate change.</p> <p>This qualification has been developed in close consultation with the Fleet Operators Recognition Scheme, training associations and industry to ensure that the qualification meets the needs of the transport and education sectors.
