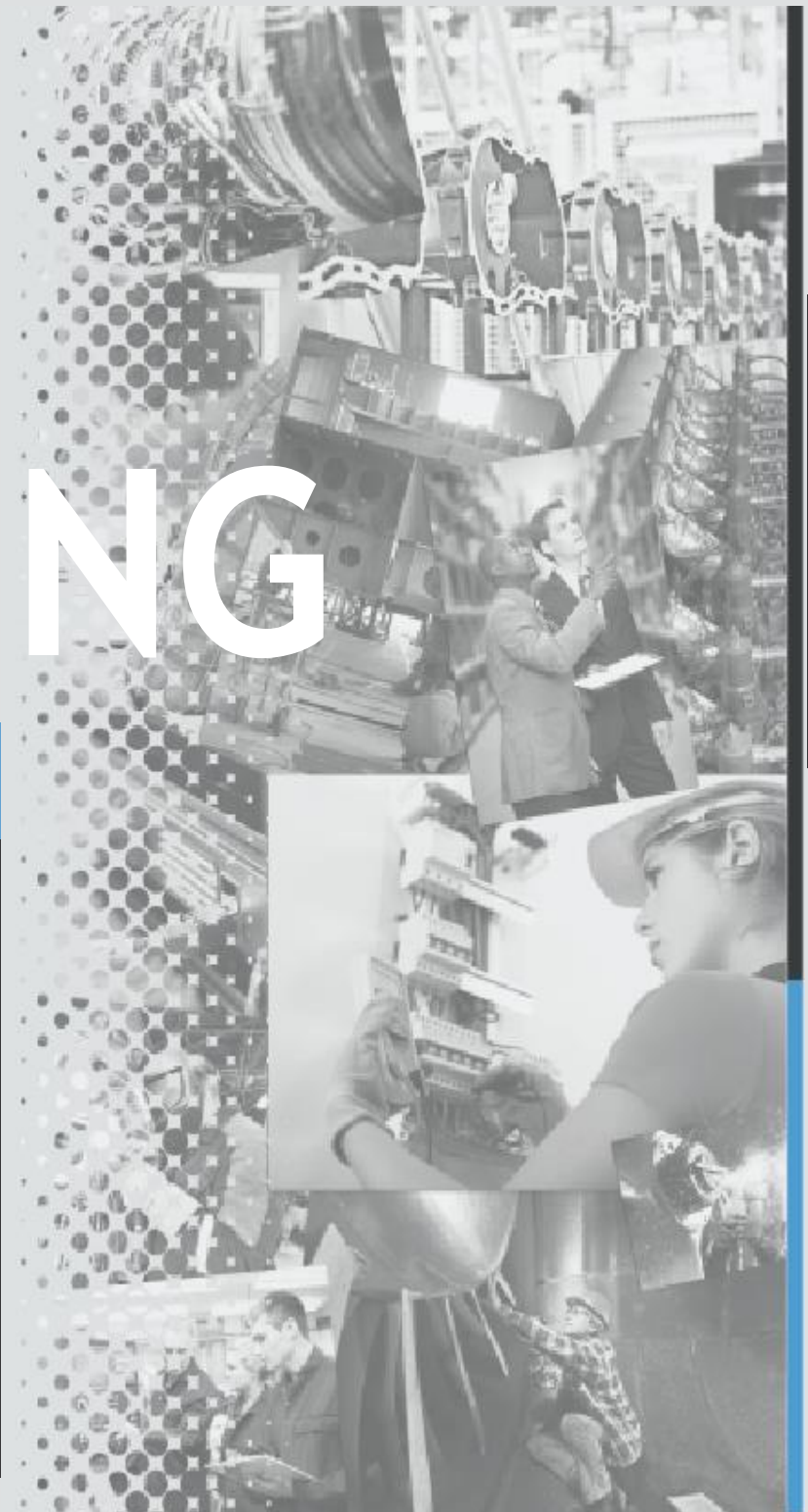
### Overview
