Purpose of the qualification

This EAL qualification covers the knowledge and skills required to be able to apply for a position within the advanced manufacturing and logistics sector. The qualification has 5 mandatory units.

What could this qualification lead to?

This qualification supports learners to move into employment or further study.

Entry Requirements

Learners must have the potential to achieve the assessment criteria set out in the units. There are no entry qualifications required by learners to undertake this qualification unless this is a legal requirement of the process or the environment. Assessment is open to any learner who has the potential to achieve the assessment criteria set out in the assessment routes.

How is the qualification achieved?

The learner must present evidence which clearly shows they have met the assessment criteria and learning outcomes.

What will be assessed?

All evidence submitted by the learner against the assessment criteria.

How will it be assessed?

This qualification is assessed by a series of internal (centre marked) assignments.

Structure

This qualification has 130 guided learning hours (GLH) and 13 credits. It has a total qualification time of 130 hours which is the notional time required by the learner to complete the qualification. The learner must complete all of the mandatory units.
