## Purpose of the qualification

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This qualification prepares learners by giving them the technical skills and knowledge to work within the industry and leads on to more specialised study at level 4 and 5.

It is intended for learners already in the workforce seeking to gain formal recognition, or for those learners looking to enter the industry..

## What could this qualification lead to?

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This qualification can be used as an introduction to Horology and can lead to further, specialized study at levels 4 and 5 .

## Entry Requirements

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Learners must have the potential to achieve the assessment criteria set out in the units.

## How is the qualification achieved?

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The learner must present verifiable evidence which clearly shows they have met the assessment criteria and learning outcomes.

## What will be assessed?

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All evidence submitted by the learner against the assessment criteria.

## How will it be assessed?

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The assessment of this qualification is by combination of:

- completion of a portfolio of evidence
- multiple choice examination
- practical assignments and examinations

## Structure

This qualification has 300 guided learning hours (GLH) and 42 credits. It has a total qualification time of 420 hours which is the notional time required by the learner to complete the qualification. The learner must take the 2 mandatory units to achieve 30 credits, plus at least ONE of the optional units to achieve the remaining 12 required credits
