Purpose of qualification

What does this qualification cover?

The qualification has two mandatory units, health, safety and security at work, and develop effective working relationships, and a range of optional units to choose from dependent on current or intended job role.

Who is this qualification for?

- Learners who are already in employment within the Logistics Industry in a Warehouse and Storage facility, distribution centre, transport or freight forwarding operation. It is particularly relevant to those who already have basic experience and an understanding of the logistics industry.
- All learners undertaking a warehousing or logistics apprenticeship.
- All learners aged 16 and above who are capable of meeting the standards.
- Learners who wish to gain a knowledge and understanding of the Logistic sector
- Those who are new to the sector or looking for a career change or wish to learn new skills

Who supports the qualification?

This qualification:

- is accredited by Ofqual at level 2.
- is endorsed by employers from within the industry.
- forms part of an approved apprenticeship framework.

What could this qualification lead to?

This qualification can lead to further engineering qualifications, apprenticeship and employment.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification; however centres should ensure that the learners have the potential to achieve this qualification. Learners must have the minimum levels of literacy and numeracy to complete the learning outcomes and the assessments.

How is the qualification achieved?

The qualification is achieved when all the necessary units have been completed. The centre will then be able to apply for the learner's certificate of achievement. The learners will also receive a certificate of unit credit, listing all the units they have achieved.

What will be assessed?

The performance, knowledge and understanding of warehousing and storage.

How will it be assessed?

This qualification is assessed by the internal (centre marked) portfolio of evidence.

Structure

This qualification will be obtained by the learner once they have completed the mandatory units in Group A1 plus the required number of units and credits from groups B to F as shown below. The qualification requires learners to achieve a minimum of 26 credits and has 101 guided learning hours.
