What activities are involved?

- drafting assessment content – e.g. multiple-choice questions, professional, practical assignments, employer-set project content
- reviewing and amending specialism/assessment content as part of editing panels
- feeding into grading profile development – e.g. drafting guidance around what merit, distinction etc looks like
- calculating and reviewing content learning hour values.

What experience is required?

Our technical consultants are subject matter experts who come from a range of backgrounds including colleges, training providers and employers. You will need,

- up-to-date subject matter knowledge and practical subject experience
- teaching or assessment experience in the relevant subject and level
- an understanding of target learners and their needs
- a passion for developing quality educational resources.

In addition, an understanding of current qualification design and delivery practice would be a bonus.
